Trip details

New Mexico Mission Trip – Pine Hill Church, near Cuba New Mexico November 22-25, Friday- Monday

Mandatory meeting for EVERYONE going on the trip Nov. 17th immediately following the Sunday morning service.

The cost for this trip is \$25 per family, your gas and meals to and from the reservation.

SLEEPING ARRANGEMENTS

Cots work best for this trip! PLEASE DO NOT BRING QUEEN OR DOUBLE SIZE AIR MATTRESSES SINCE THERE IS LIMITED SPACE FOR SLEEPING.

Meals

Each Missionary will be responsible for 3 Fast Food meals (approx. \$8 each), and 1 sit down meal (approx. \$12 each), the other meals we will eat on the reservation.

SHOWERS Please bring baby wipes!!

TRANSPORTATION

Each family will be responsible for their own transportation and gas. (Approx. \$200 round-trip) Combining families to take fewer vehicles and split gas cost is highly encouraged. If you do not have reliable transportation of your own, or are a youth going without a parent, contact Price Ferrell for help with arrangements.

Tribes

We will be traveling in "Tribes" of 2 to 3 cars to help accommodate bathroom stops (QUICK STOPS) and overall ease of travel. Tribes must stay together.

CHILDren

We love kids, we love serving along side them & kids are welcome!. However, please remember everyone is responsible for their own children for the ENTIRE trip. No childcare is provided.

TENTATIVE SCHEDULE ALL TIMES ARE CENTRAL STANDARD TIME

Friday Schedule
2pm - Meet at Grace Bible to pray and hit the road.
8pm - Arrive in Amarillo and eat dinner with your tribe.
9:30pm - Tribes arrive at Amarillo Fellowship Church for the night.

Saturday Schedule 6:00am - Leave TOGETHER as a "Tribe" forPine Hill Church. (EachTribe is responsible for breakfast and lunch before arriving at Pine Hill.) 2:00pm - Arrive at Pine Hill Church 2:00pm Unload, Set Up, Prepare food, etc There is a worship service planned for this evening. Time TBD. 10:45pm - Quiet time then lights out

Sunday Schedule (subject to change) WE ALL MUST BE FLEXIBLE ON THIS DAY... Times will be revealed throughout the day. We will Serve lunch immediately after church services at Pine Hill. Then, EVERYONE WILL NEED TO HELP CLEAN UP. Leave Pine Hill and head for Amarillo Arrive in Amarillo, eat dinner and stay the night at Amarillo Fellowship.

Monday Schedule (subject to change) Monday's objective is to make it back home safe and sound with an approximate arrival time of 2-3pm.

some other things to consider:

Rest:

An overly tired worker may not be able to minister effectively when opportunities arise. It is important that everyone pace himself or herself throughout the weekend. It is highly encouraged to share driving responsibilities to give everyone adequate amounts of rest.

Weather:

We will be on the high planes desert in winter. It will be COLD, please prepare by wearing and bringing appropriate clothing, SLEEPING BAG, etc. Bring stuff to keep you warm.

Stops:

When stopping for gas, food or restroom breaks, please make these trips as QUICK as possible and limit the number of times you are stopping! This will ensure everyone is arriving on time.

Local area information:

The closest city is Cuba NM, about 45 minutes away from Pine Hill Church. It has a gas station, McDonalds, health clinic, and a Family Dollar. This would be for extreme needs only. These are NOT easily accessible from where we are staying, nor will our schedule allow for last minute shopping.

WHAT TO BRING Guidelines:

1. Please pack lightly.

2. Again it will most likely be cold. Dress accordingly. Also, how you dress is a part of your Christian witness; don't wear anything that would be offensive to someone else.

BASICS/MISC:

Bible

A flexible and servant-like heart and attitude!

Sleeping bag

Pillow

Cot or Air Mattress (space is limited, if you bring an mattress that is big enough for 4 people, 4 people will need to share it with you) Flashlight

4 Sets of Clothes (remember to layer for warmth)

Ear Plugs

TOILETRIES, ETC:

Soap, Shampoo/conditioner, Hand sanitizer Deodorant,

Toothbrush/toothpaste

Towels

Chap stick (it's DRY up there)

Baby wipes (they may be your only bath)

CLOTHES: Work clothes: clothes you can work in and be warm. Casual clothes for evening times and traveling .

Sweater, sweatshirt, coat (it is COLD on the reservation.)
